Mires Beck Nursery is a Registered Charity with the primary aim of providing horticultural training and work experience for people who have a learning difficulty or disability. Our constant aim is that all who come to the nursery will enjoy and benefit from being involved in a productive, therapeutic and creative work environment. Our experience has shown that people who are involved in the wide range of activities undertaken here develop practical and social skills and grow in confidence and self-esteem.

An extensive range of plants are grown at the nursery including herbaceous perennials, wildflowers, shrubs and herbs. Everyone coming to Mires Beck is involved in the production and care of these plants. Every aspect of the plant's production is carried out by hand by our trainees. This includes propagation, potting up and weeding. Before being sent out for sale our plant preparation team collect the orders, clean and label each plant individually before putting in marketing trays for delivery. We take great pride in the quality of our plants, displays and presentation which is why customers come back.

Our plants are grown outside all year long in peat free compost with a slow release feed. In light of recent environmental concerns we have taken the decision to move away from black pots to taupe pots which can be recycled at the kerbside. In addition all our labels are fully recyclable. In order to ensure that we do not waste our existing stock of pots this will be a phased process throughout the year and some varieties will still be produced in black pots.

We are fully compliant with the new plant passport regulations and can supply documentation in an easily accessible format for your records as well as labelling the plants.

At Mires Beck we continually assess which plants are performing well and watch the market place carefully to see which plants are in fashion. We have discontinued plants that we feel do not perform well and taken the opportunity to introduce new and exciting varieties. The new plants are listed at the front of the catalogue and are highlighted in green text throughout. The catalogue is compiled alphabetically and details pot size, flower colour, height and whether the plant has been awarded the RHS Award of Garden Merit.

As part of our service to garden centres we offer pre-priced and bar-coded labels. Our labels have full colour pictures, plant descriptions and planting information. Throughout the summer we offer free delivery on our regular delivery days. A weekly availability list is sent out. In order to keep things simple all plants are priced according to pot size and colour rather than variety.

Ajuga are great for providing Autumn foliage colour in planted containers and at the front of the border. This variety has shiny black bronze leaves. In late Spring short blue flower panicles appear above the foliage.

An unusual Ajuga which has lime/yellow leaves with pale pink flowers in early Spring. This herbaceous perennial is low growing and great for ground cover

Perfect for providing colourful ground cover in a shady corner. The rounded leaves are streaked and spotted with bronze, yellow, pink and cream. Spike like whorls or deep blue flowers are produced in spring.

A compact low growing perennial that forms a cushion of green with stems of bright pink pom pom like flowers over a long season from Spring through to Summer.

A wonderful variety of Centaurea with large plum purple thistle like flowers, that are attractive to bees and butterflies, in late Spring and early Summer. The spent seed heads can last well in to Autumn.

Very similar in habit to the wild corn flower. This variety has attractive feathery white flowers with a contrasting violet/purple centre. The flowers appear upon short sturdy stems above clumps of grey/green leaves. Enjoys full sun or part shade in a well drained soil.

A hardy Chrysanthemum with a dense habit and single daisy like flowers. It flowers over a long period in autumn and is ideal for the late border. The flowers are deep pink with green centres held above dissected mid-green foliage.

A lovely new Coreopsis providing compact mounds of dense thread-like foliage. The foliage is covered with startling, yellow and red bi-coloured flowers.

A fabulous perennial for the front of the border with masses of daisy like bright yellow flowers with an orange centre. Some coreopsis can be quite short lived, only lasting 3 years, however the rhizomatous species have greater longevity.

A fabulous plant for the border and cut flower garden. It produces semi-double golden flowers above beautiful green foliage.

The Japanese Painted Fern is one of the most popular ferns grown today. Great for a shady border. The fronds appear painted and this variety boasts strong colours. It is silvery grey-green with deep wine-red colour towards the centre and pronounced burgundy midribs.
