Wildflower Production

We grow thousands of Yorkshire species wildflowers each year and have official days when these delicate seedlings are 'pricked out' to be planted into our special cells which house this stock.

This period is usually between May – June and can only be determined when stock is ready. Being a natural product, we are weather dependent.

This work requires delicate hands and attention to detail and early arrival is required for training before these tiny plants are transferred from seed trays.

3 weeks notice is given for this activity once people are recorded as interested.

Vegetable Production

Our vegetable production is volunteer led and requires support from people interested in food growing.

We use the fresh vegetables and herbs onsite on our café event days and to sell in our retail area.

We have 10 large vegetable beds which need weeding, watering and composting.

Stock needs picking each week for retail, especially for the weekends and events. Some vegetable know how would be appreciated.

Seasonal Plant Work

We grow over 50,000 plants and herbs each year and supply onsite retail and wholesale customers.

Plant work includes:

- Potting Up/ Weeding/ Propagation/Watering
- Preparing For Dispatch/Labelling/Pot Recycling
- ✤ We are happy to introduce people to these tasks from March to August.
- The stock must be displayed for our onsite retail, and we hold regular events where replenishment of benches and beds is essential.
- Help in this work is always required.
- During the season we dry culinary herbs to sell in our retail hut and at the end of the season harvest lavender from our gardens to turn into gifts.
- We are happy to invite people to join the lavender harvest at 2 weeks notice at the end of summer.

Craft For Retail

- All our wood craft is made by volunteers. We use all donated wood to make bird boxes, bug hotels, insect and bat boxes.
- We also make art for our woodland to enhance the customer journey.
- The insect boxes and bug hotels require various 'inners' and are made to order depending on size and price.
- Interest in woodcraft or skills in carpentry would be helpful to our volunteers who only work one day per week.
